

SJH Advanced Critical Care Echocardiography Course



Friday 28 & Saturday 29 March 2025, St. James's Hospital, Dublin

This 2-day EDEC level course is designed for clinicians aiming to acquire advanced echocardiography knowledge and skills to enhance their management of acutely unwell patients. Course participants should possess basic echocardiography skills (performed ≥20 basic level scans) and have completed, or be actively pursuing, FUSIC Heart, BSE Level 1 or EDEC accreditation. Places are strictly limited to ensure optimal course trainer to participant ratios.

The course incorporates interactive lectures and hands-on transthoracic and transoesophageal scanning with advanced faculty to cover a range of core topics, including:

Extended transthoracic 2D views
Basic transoesophageal probe handling and views
Introduction to colour Doppler physics
Valvular assessment using 2D and colour Doppler

Spectral Doppler in haemodynamic assessment Extended left ventricular assessment Extended right ventricular assessment Pericardial effusion and cardiac tamponade
